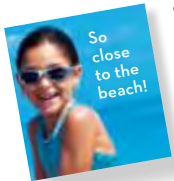

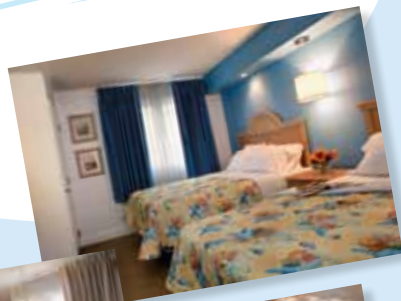

Located in Colonial County, Haddonfield was the second municipality in New Jersey (after Cape May) to establish a historical preservation district. One way Haddonfield celebrates its heritage is by hosting town-wide festivals and events throughout the year.

### What We Love

**THE ENTERTAINMENT:** The town will be lit with fireworks during the holiday season. On Friday evenings through December, the streets will be lit with sparkling lights, brightly lit trees and filled with music provided by a variety of local groups, musicians, performers and choiring ensembles. (Some will also offer extended hours.) On Saturdays and Sunday afternoons, keep an eye out for horse-drawn carriage rides and Santa appearances. On December 31, the downtown area will come alive in color in the form of the New Year's Eve celebration. The celebration will feature live music, local and international performers, plus early bird fireworks along Haddonfield's picturesque main thoroughfare, Kings Highway. Although the main street is highly walkable, trolley transportation will also be provided that day.

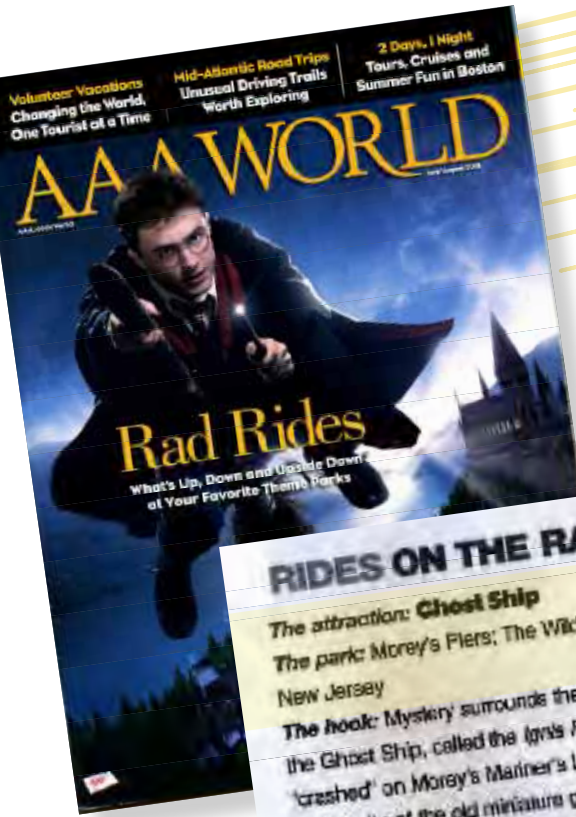

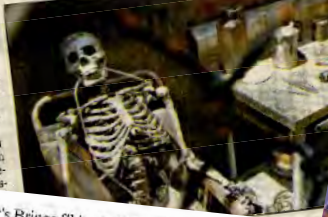

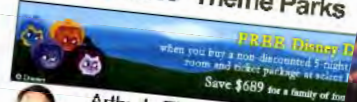

# Seed Money

Jersey's going to seed — in a good way. The New Jersey Audubon will make its final delivery of Jersey-grown birdseed on Feb. 12 to stores throughout the state.

NJA began making the much sought-after S.A.V.E. seed available in the fall with drop offs in October and early December. This is the final seed of the season.

About 140 acres of Jersey farmland was dedicated to growing sunflowers this year. And for every 176 acres planned for birdseed, NJA manages and maintains one acre

of grassland habitat for threatened and endangered birds.

Prices for the seed vary, but at NJA stores, a 25-pound bag costs \$23 and a 60-pound bag is \$42. Seed grown through the S.A.V.E. (Support Agricultural Viability and the Environment) program is available at NJA stores throughout the state and at selected retailers. Sales benefit New Jersey farmers and support NJA's conservation mission.

Some farmers who participated in the program also are selling seed. They include Brodhoeker Farms in Newton (Sussex County), Raj Saha of Liberty Farms in Sandyton (Sussex County) and Laine Farm in Hillsborough (Somerset County).

Additional farmers/growers in the S.A.V.E. birdseed program include Warren County farmer Brand Gibbs of Allamuchy, and Roger Woolf of Washington, along with Sussex County farmer Jeff Angelo of Layton.

# State launches bid to boost N.J.-grown wood products

EGG HARBOR CITY — "Jersey Fresh" as a food label has become an easily recognizable way to find high-quality, locally grown produce in the Garden State. Now, a new effort announced Tuesday aims to attract people to locally harvested wood products.

The "Made with Jersey-Grown Wood" stamp will first be emblazoned on birdhouses and birdfeeders crafted from Atlantic white cedar trees grown in Atlantic County and cut by the Schairer Bros. Saw Mill on Brecken Avenue. The goal is to promote the state's dwindling saw mill as well as the practice of sustainable tree harvesting through an easily identifiable logo.

"The opportunities are limitless," said state Agriculture Secretary Douglas Fisher, whose department teamed with the New Jersey Audubon Society for the project. "I

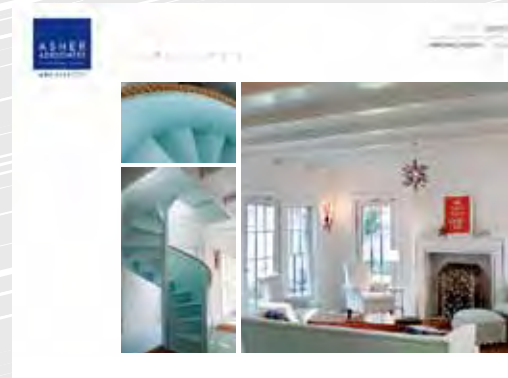
